



**Article IV. Limitations**

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the society shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) an unincorporated association exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an unincorporated association, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

**Article V. Composition of the Society**

The governing document of this association is the Bylaws of the Research Center Administrators Society. The society shall be composed of voting members as described in the Bylaws of the society. The society shall have an executive committee, other committees, and such officers as are necessary to fulfill its objectives as described in the Bylaws of the society.

**Article VI. Dissolution**

Upon dissolution of the association, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, or for a public purposes.
